### AMBIENT+STUDIO

ATLANTA

**COST** From \$4,300

**GUEST COUNT** 300

**ABOUT** Originally built as a photography and film studio, this industrial joint (above) lends itself to A+ wedding photos, thanks to an open layout, wood floors and lots of natural light.



### THE DRAYTON HOTEL

SAVANNAH

**COST** From \$6,000

**GUEST COUNT** 100

**ABOUT** Located in the heart of Savannah's Historic District, the hotel's hand-painted wall art and plush furniture in pop-y hues embrace the region's rich history and culture.



### THE WHEELER HOUSE

BALL GROUND

**COST** From \$12,750

**GUEST COUNT** 300

**ABOUT** This quaint barn and historic home packs on the Southern charm with old oak trees and wraparound porches. String lights and chandeliers will accentuate your newlywed glow.



### THE VINE'S GARDEN + ATELIER

**CATOR WOOLFORD GARDENS**

**ABOUT** One of the few remaining historic estates in Atlanta, this haven provides an enchanting setting for "I do" with vaulted ceilings and a dreamy pavilion.
